Why support the Foundation?

There is an overwhelming need to help people in our community who have few, if any, options to find assistance in attaining the life's basic needs. The Anthony V. Spano Foundation exists to ensure that individuals and families with these needs receive the financial help necessary to provide food, clothing, shelter or medical attention.

Often, organizations that serve the basic needs of members of the community are themselves in need of financial assistance. They may be underfunded through a lack of donations or grants. Eligibility for Organizations

- Organizations whose mission or programs focus on serving economically disadvantaged people.
- Organizations that are financially sustainable but in need of resources to fulfill their mission.
- Tax-exempt organizations described in Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and governmental entities are eligible to apply for these grants.
- Organizations must be located in or serving one of more of the following Ohio counties: Mahoning, Trumbull and Columbiana.
- Organizations that have not received an Anthony V. Spano Foundation grant in the last 12 months.
